 - **Supporting business decisions and policy-making**

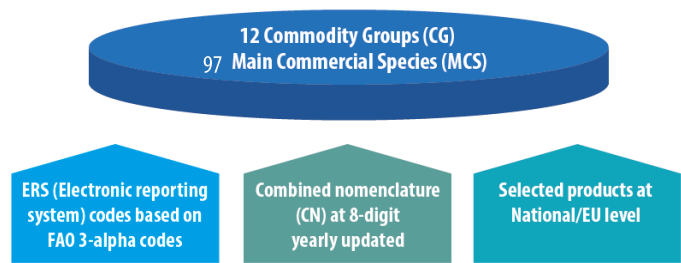

METHODS

Data harmonisation

Data are harmonised in order to enable EUMOFA's end-users to easily select different fishery products or to allow comparisons along the supply chain. Conversion factors have also been developed for homogenising volumes from net weight to live weight equivalent.
