**1. Whether does your organization maintain IUU list? If yes, please describe the criteria to determine whether a certain vessels/activities to be included in the list.**

Yes, CCAMLR maintains a list of IUU fishing vessels which is compiled in accordance with CCAMLR Conservation Measure 10-06 ([http://www.ccamlr.org/pu/e/e\\_pubs/cm/09-10/10-06.pdf](http://www.ccamlr.org/pu/e/e_pubs/cm/09-10/10-06.pdf)).

**2. Does your organization estimate the amount of catch taken by IUU activities? If so, please describe briefly the estimation procedures.**

Yes, the Secretariat annually prepares an estimate of IUU catches of toothfish in the CCAMLR Convention Area. The current method is based on Members' reports of sightings of IUU fishing vessels and information from surveillance operations. The method also uses ancillary information from CCAMLR's Catch Documentation Scheme and catch rates reported from legal fishing vessels. This method is being further developed.
