Underground (Metro)

There are two underground lines in Rome called Line A and Line B. The stops are marked by a red metal disk showing a white “M” sign. The “Terminal” is the only Metro station where the two lines intersect. The Metro stop for FAO is “Circo Massimo” (Line B). Participants are reminded that tickets must be purchased before boarding, cost Euro 1.50.
