Priority level – Minimum requirements

- Essential (minimum requirements for the Global Record)
 - UVI
 - Name
 - Flag
 - LOA
 - GT
- High priority
- Low priority





Information modules

- Vessel details
- Historical details
- Authorization details
- Inspection and surveillance
- Port entry denial
- IUU lists





Data fields, reference lists & definitions

- Vessel details:

New data fields: AIS, name in English, IMO Company number for owner, beneficial owner and operator/manager

Address high priority, but nationality removed

- Historical details:

New data fields: Previous operator/manager, change date

All fields high priority

- Authorization details:

Multiple instances





Data fields, reference lists & definitions

- Inspection and surveillance details:

Module: Option 1 (from Appendix 2 of Strategy document)

Infringement/apparent infringement reference list: option 2 (serious violations on UN fish stocks agreement)

Include also positive reports

- Port entry denial:

Port reference list (States notifying ports)

- IUU lists:

Listing link Url, RFMOs to report





Pending items

- Vessel details:
 - National/regional VMS indicator
 - Fish hold capacity: low priority?
 - Fish hold type? Ref. list?
- Authorization details
 - Reason for revocation: text or ref.?
- Inspection and surveillance:
 - New details master and fishing master?
 - Expand “infringement/app.infr.” Reference list?
 - Different data providers for “Outcome”
- Port entry denials
 - Reason for denial: text or ref. list?
- Other
 - Procedure to report port codes and names
 - Authorization info, rapidly changing: scope?



Ongoing discussions





Data providers

- States are responsible for the information and its submission to the Global Record (COFI31, GRWG1, GRCG1)
- Each information module separately
- Interim measures? (Pilot project?)
 - 5 essential fields
 - IHSM data (GRCG-TP)
- Source of data clearly marked
- Time frame overlaps? (data conflicts doc)
- Owner of information (generator)
- Timely and accurate information

Data conflicts

- Data inconsistencies
 - Comparison with TP data (IHSM)
 - Vessel and historical details
 - Double flagging
 - 5 essential fields only? All?
 - Historical info? Time overlaps?
 - Secondary data providers?
- Data conflicts
 - Hiding? (analyze and update)
 - Flagging record
 - Replacing with newest
 - Other?
 - Same weight? (essential fields)
 - Automated procedure (editorial board?)
