## GUIDELINES TO CONTRIBUTORS FOR THE PREPARATION OF THE MANUSCRIPTS

Authors must deposit the first draft text of their paper (abstract, text, references, tables and figures) in an electronic format **not later than 3 March 2008**. The mail must be labelled with the name of the first author and the three first words of the title.

The complete texts of the oral contributions and of the posters will be published in the Proceedings volume as soon as possible after the Symposium.

The title should clearly indicate the subject, but should be kept as short as possible.

Arrange material for each manuscript as follows: NAME, FULL ADDRESS and EMAIL (see example below):

Note that names of all authors should be given.

Texts must be in English or French and submitted as MS Word Files. The text should be set in Times New Roman, size 12 and line spacing 1.5, with a margin of 2.5 cm. Number the pages.

### Tables/Figures

Indicate the approximate position of tables and illustrations in the typescript.  
Example: **[Figure 1 here]** **[Table 2 here]**

Tables and illustrations must be submitted electronically.

All tables and illustrations should have a concise but self-explanatory caption. All the illustrations of a paper (whether drawings, diagrams or photographs) should be numbered consecutively throughout.

Photos and figures should be sent in separate files. Please send high resolution original files (photos in jpeg high resolution or tiff, figures in Excel format).

All illustrations must be clear, clean and ready for publication. All figure components (including letters and symbols) must be sufficiently large to permit severe reduction without loss of quality.

### Units

Physical units should conform to the International Systems of Units (SI). We remind that symbols are not followed by a dot, remain invariable (even in the plural) and are identical in all languages. Authors should consequently write m, km, ha, kg, etc. (**not** m., Km, Kms, Ha, kgr, Kgrs).

### References

References in the text should be given as follows:

- (a) According to Burgis (1995)
  - (b) According to some recent data (Burgis, 1995)
  - (c) At the end of a sentence: (Burgis, 1995)
- and for multiple names (Burgis, 1995; Johnson, 2002; Liew, 1999).

The titles of authors cited should be omitted: write 'According to Burgis (1995) ...' not 'According to Prof. Burgis (1995).'

The references should be listed in alphabetical order of the first author, and for the same author (or team of authors) in chronological order. References should be given as follows (by alphabetical order):
