Subject: New ASFA Thesaurus to replace existing one in www-ISIS-ASFA v1.1 software

Dear ASFA Partners,

The ASFA Thesaurus has now been updated with some 200 additional terms.

Attached to this e-mail you will find:

- a zipped attachment called **AsfaTh.zip** containing the new ASFA Thesaurus files.

Follow the procedure below to copy the contents of **AsfaTh.zip** into the www-ISIS-ASFA v1.1 software, so as to replace the existing thesaurus pick-list (files) contained in the Subject Descriptors field. (Note, this same file attachment (**AsfaTh.zip**) is also available for downloading from the FAO FTP site at <ftp://ext-ftp.fao.org/FI/Data/FIES/> in the folder called **New ASFA Thesaurus picklist**)

The step-by-step procedure for copying AsfaTh.zip into the www-ISIS-ASFA 1.1 software is listed below:

- 1) <Save> the zipped file (**AsfaTh.zip**) to your hard disk (using the one attached to this e-mail or the one downloaded from the above mentioned FAO FTP site)
- 2) <Double click> on the **AsfaTh.zip** file to open it (the WinZip utility will display the 8 files which need to be copied)
- 3) <Click> on **Extract**
- 4) In the "**Extract to**" box, type the following location **C:\Xitam\webpages\DB\Asfa\Asfath**
- 5) <Click> on **Extract**. The 8 files that you are extracting to the location **C:\Xitam\webpages\DB\Asfa\AsfaTh** have the same name as the 8 existing files which you want to replace, therefore you will be presented with a Windows "**Confirm file overwrite**" message saying: "This folder already contains this file".
- 6) <Click> on the option **Yes to all**

Note that the location of the databases may be different depending on which drive the software was installed. Therefore, should you have a problem in finding the exact location of the **AsfaTh** folder, the easiest solution will be to search for the ASFATH.MST file using "Windows Search for Files or Folders" option.

For your information: the 200 new terms added to the ASFA Thesaurus are listed in the attached text file called **AsfaThesNewTerms.txt**. A printed version of the revised ASFA Thesaurus will eventually be issued and then mailed to you in due course.
