Citation analysis

The Fisheries and Aquaculture Branch Library contributes to the evaluation of impact of "The State of World Fisheries and Aquaculture 2012" through conducting a citation analysis based on SCOPUS data. In addition to identifying articles that cite SOFIA 2012, we perform a content search to see to which particular part of the text this citing source refers to. Results so far are available [here](#); we intend to update them regularly. More detailed research into the impact evaluation of SOFIA and other publications by the Department is under negotiation for inclusion as case-studies into the project "Investigating and enhancing the policy relevance of marine scientific information (especially grey literature) through multi-partner collaboration", coordinated by Prof. Bertrum H. MacDonald from Dalhousie University, and funded by the Canadian Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council.
