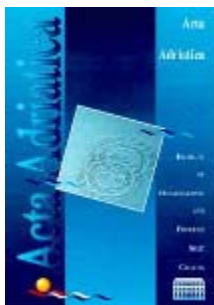

Publishing and copyright

Unsure about your author's rights when you publish? Lost between copyright and copyleft, open access and creative commons? You can't remember the "colour" of the publisher? SHERPA/RoMEO, the website on publisher copyright policies and self-archiving, can help you in checking your rights if you want to publish in an scientific journal. See also the pages on the intranet on "publishing in external journals".



RoMEO Colour	Archiving policy
Green	Can archive pre-print <i>and</i> post-print or publisher's version/PDF
Blue	Can archive post-print (ie final draft post-refereeing) or publisher's version/PDF
Yellow	Can archive pre-print (ie pre-refereeing)
White	Archiving not formally supported
