### Access to library resources from your tablet or smartphone

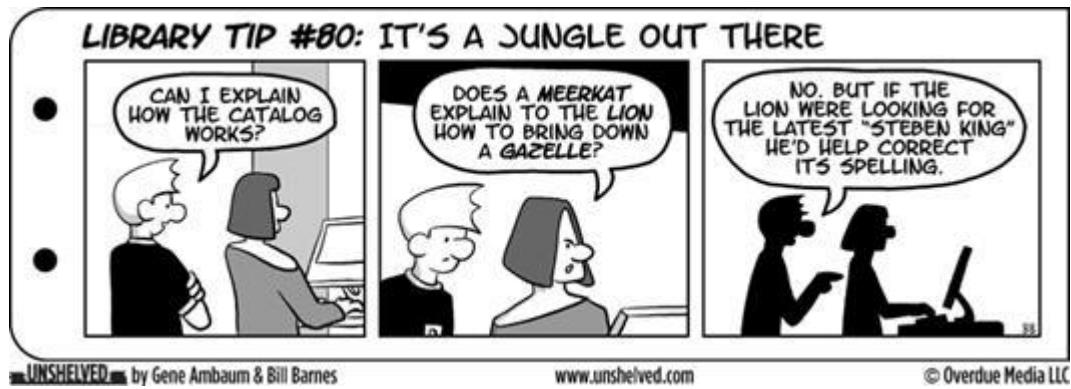


An increasing number of library journals and databases are also accessible from tablet or smartphone. For some journals, like *Science and Nature*, publishers, like Elsevier (ScienceDirect), and databases, like Scopus, apps are available, though not always compatible with both iOS and Android. Other publishers have a dedicated mobile friendly website; e.g. Taylor & Francis gives the possibility to pair your mobile device and access the Library subscriptions. Also World Bank offers specialized apps. In short: you may take your library with you on your holiday!
