Our proposal to host the 41st [IAMSLIC](#) Annual Conference in 2015 as FAO co-sponsored event here in Rome has recently been cleared by ODG. FAO has already hosted the conference of the International Association of Aquatic and Marine Science Libraries and Information Centers (IAMSLIC) in 2005. That meeting brought together more than 140 participants and was a very successful event. FAO has a Memorandum of Understanding with IAMSLIC and activities that our library and the ASFA Secretariat are part of include: Resource Sharing Program, Aquatic Commons digital repository, and

cooperation with UNESCO IOC/IODE.

'The gold open-access model has given rise to a great many new online publishers. Many of these publishers are corrupt and exist only to make money off the author processing charges that are billed to authors upon acceptance of their scientific manuscripts,' Jeffrey Beall, an academic librarian from the University of Colorado, says. 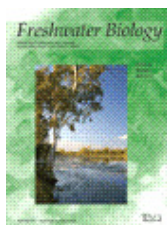


Pêcheurs du monde

The international film festival *Pêcheurs du monde* was held in Lorient, France, from 19-24 March and the program included 44 films. Among the [price winners](#) are "Down East" – a documentary on a sardine cannery in New England, "Pirate Fishermen in South Africa," "Tagikaks Once Were Hunters" - about a whale hunter community by the Bering Strait, and "Leviathan" – an experimental documentary about commercial fishing industry.

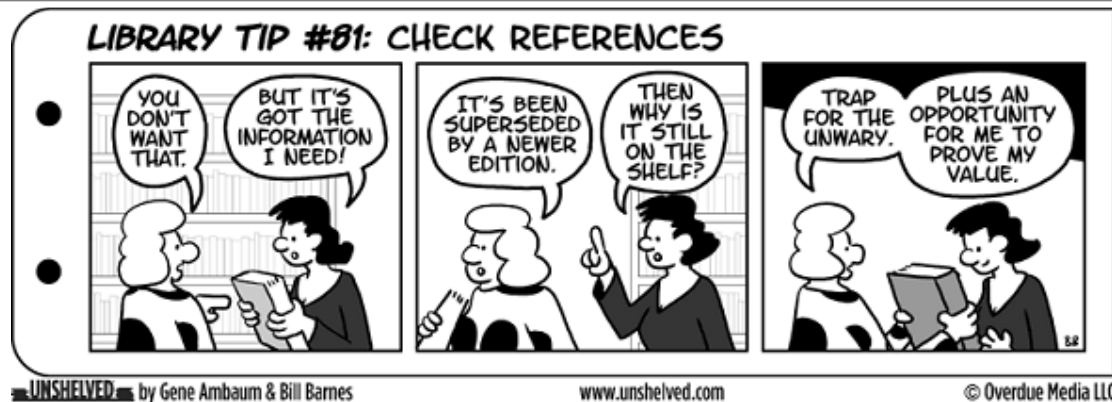
