Dr Piero Mannini joined the Fisheries and Aquaculture Department of FAO in 1990. He holds a doctorate in Fisheries Ecology. His early work with FAO included project management and the implementation of cooperative fishery research in Eastern, Central and Southern Africa. Since 1999 he has worked to the establishment of the regional framework of FAO fishery projects in the Mediterranean. At the FAO Headquarters in Rome Piero was Programme Coordinator with the Fisheries Management and Conservation Service with the responsibility for the formulation and implementation of regional projects operating in the Mediterranean and Arabian Sea. In February 2008 he was appointed Senior Fishery Officer at the FAO Regional Office for the Near East and North Africa in Cairo (Egypt), his responsibilities also included acting as Executive Secretary of the Regional Commission for Fisheries (RECOFI). Starting from July 2014 Piero is Senior Liaison Officer at the Fisheries and Aquaculture Division in FAO (Rome). He is also the Secretary of the Regional Fishery Body Secretariats' Network. Piero has authored more than 100 scientific and technical publications and has more than 30 years of combined experience in fisheries research and management, including coordination of international cooperation for fisheries sustainability, implementation of global and regional fishery policies and instruments.
