Background

The Water Scarcity Initiative (WSI) by the FAO Near East and North Africa (NENA) region was launched in 2013 to address the region's growing water challenges, exacerbated by climate change, population growth and unsustainable water management. It aims to enhance water productivity in agriculture, improve governance and promote sustainable water resource management through policy support, capacity building, and innovative solutions.

To further facilitate global knowledge exchange and collaboration on water scarcity challenges In June 2022, FAO NENA office launched the Inter-Regional Technical Platform on Water Scarcity (iRTP-WS) as a Centre of Excellence and a Gateway to Coping with Water Scarcity. Its objective is to support countries and regions in scaling up water-related actions, identifying gaps in practice and innovation and fostering transformative change in the management of water, land and agriculture under the impacts of climate change. This platform aims to build action-oriented and results-based partnerships to accelerate progress towards the 2030 SDGs.

The Cairo Water Week (CWW) 2025, under the theme Water for Climate Action, will gather policymakers, scientists, development partners, the private sector and civil society to share knowledge and experiences, strengthen partnerships and shape collective responses to the growing impacts of climate change on water resources. It provides a key opportunity to highlight integrated solutions that connect water scarcity with food security, sustainable agriculture and resilience.

Within this context, the participation of iRTP-WS at CWW 2025 through a dedicated booth addresses a dual purpose: reinforcing the platform's visibility and recognition as a global reference on agricultural water scarcity and creating a physical space for interaction, dialogue and partnership-building. The booth will serve both as a showcase for existing knowledge products and tools and as a meeting point where stakeholders can engage directly with the platform, exchange experiences and explore opportunities for collaboration. It thus represents a strategic investment in positioning iRTP-WS within the international water agenda.





Strategic alignment between Cairo Water Week and iRTP-WS

The overarching theme of Cairo Water Week 2025, "Water for Climate Action", aligns with the mission of the Inter-Regional Technical Platform on Water Scarcity (iRTP-WS). While CWW offers a global convening space, iRTP-WS brings a technical and inter-regional perspective to the water—agriculture nexus. The Platform supports climate resilience through climate-smart water management, strengthens evidence-based policy with data and knowledge systems, promotes innovation and partnerships and advances food security by optimizing water use in agriculture.

Under the iRTP-WS technical theme For 2024-2025, "Integrated Water Solutions: Navigating Climate Change and WEFE Nexus Dynamics", iRTP-WS contributes to advancing integrated solutions to agricultural water scarcity by fostering inclusive WEFE nexus dialogues among governments, academia, private sector and civil society.
