The challenge of gender equality in the forest sector became more evident with the commitments with 2030 Agenda – SDG 5 and recent inclusion inside FSC Principles and Criteria. The first forest gender outlook that was launched in 2020 shows the presence of women in around 50% of total forest plantation area in Brazil. Gender disaggregated data is the first step towards a more equal sector. The side event aims to bring private sector views around the gender outlook findings and promote a discussion with participants around other scenarios and opportunities such as partnerships and ways forward.
