Section I: Priority food Security issues and achievement of World Food Summit goals

The State of the country's security situation in terms of food (availability and stability of supply and access to food) and the progress in reaching the hunger reduction targets are described below:

An economical growth is being evident in our country during last years mainly due to the growth of agricultural production and food processing . As it was noticed in the Review of State of Food and Agriculture in the world, developed by FAO, of food and agricultural output have increased by 17,5 % in Ukraine. Thus, with respect to abovementioned indexes Ukraine occupies the 3 place among the European countries with transitive economy (after Hungary and the Czech Republic) and leaving behind even the Russian Federation and some European Union countries.

Food-processing industry is one of the most important branches of agro-industrial complex and national economy of Ukraine. The share of sold products of both of Industry and processing of agricultural production accounted 15,1% of the total amount of sold production in Ukraine in 2004 with the respect to abovementioned indexes. This branch possessed the second place after metallurgy and metal processing.

It has the most stationary and guaranteed source of receipts if to compare to another branches of Ukrainian industry. Over 60% of personal consumption of material benefits is a share of food products.

More than 22 thousand of Ukrainian enterprises manufacturing food products. More then one million people works at these enterprises.

Dynamics of agricultural output is given in statistical appendix.

Food industry is capable to file home market with food stuffs, has a significant export potential and positive balance of foreign trade.

Thus, agricultural product total export in 2005 is 4,7 billion USD, including 3,63 billion USD crop growing production export (77,7 % of agricultural product total export), and 1,04 billion USD livestock production.

The greatest share in the structure of export have following agricultural products: grain (29,6 %), oil (12,3 %), diary products (11,7 %), meat and a by-products (3,3 %), oil crop seeds cultures (2,5 %) sugar and confectionery (2,4 %) etc.

Ukrainian agricultural products are imported to the USA, CIS countries, EU, countries of African region and another.

At the UN Millennium Summit (September, 2000) the key development goals till 2015 which are known as the Millennium Development Goals were developed.

The UN main goal targeted at poverty reduction is formulated as "twice reduction of the population whose income is less than 1 USD per day". There are no persons related to the poor category in Ukraine under this criterion based on a level of cumulative incomes. Taking into consideration the fact that poverty according to this criterion level does not reflect a real situation with poverty, abovementioned index is not acceptable for the purposes of poverty estimation in Ukraine.

The problem of famine overcoming is also not actual for Ukraine. Monthly average aggregate expenses of one household accounted 1150 grivnas in accordance with the data

on inspection of household life conditions in the I half-year of 2005. Average aggregate expenses of one household member amounted 441 grivnas that is 4% more than a living wage (423 grn.) which is established, particularly, on the basis of food set sufficient for normal living of a person.

Thus, taking into consideration abovementioned, the program targeted on reaching the Millennium Development Goals at a national level provides application of international criterion for Ukraine which had been established by UN for Central and Eastern European countries that is 4,3 dollars per day at par of purchasing capacity.

Many documents were adopted and implementation of system actions on reduction of poverty level as well as its prevention in the future are developed in the way of poverty overcoming in Ukraine .

Information on external assistance programmes, including a description of their impact on hunger reduction and lessons learned, is given below:

As it was noticed in the previous section the issue of famine overcoming is not actual for Ukraine. Therefore programs of international assistance to Ukraine, aimed at solving of the abovementioned problem aren't implemented.

Since 1991 the European Union provides technical assistance to Ukraine within the framework of TACIS program aimed at the competitiveness increase of the agricultural sector of Ukrainian economy, introduction of crediting and risk insurance system for agro-industrial enterprises as well as actions on implementation of EU veterinary and fito-sanitarian requirements in Ukraine .

The European Bank of Reconstruction and Development implement the program of support of small and average scaled business in Ukraine which provides granting of favorable credits to relevant business entities.

Technical assistance programs of Food and Agricultural Organization of the United Nations implementation of which began in 2005, were aimed at the improvement of National agro-informational system of Ukraine, international accreditation of the laboratory of safety and quality of agro-industrial complex products, development and implementation of the Agricultural and Rural Development Strategy on middle term prospective.

Implementation of the World Bank project "Distribution of the state certificates on land ownership in rural area and cadastre system development" continues.

The Ministry of Agricultural Policy works on the starting of joint Ukraine/World Bank project "Development of the competitiveness of agriculture and food safety", aimed at the development of food quality and safety system in Ukraine in line with the requirements of the World Trade Organization and the European Union.

The process of forest certifications has begun since 2000. The main purpose of it is to ensure sustainable development of forestry which means creation of conditions for the integrated solving of economical, ecological and social issues by the means of improvement of registration and use of forest resources, increase of forestry management level. The first in our country "Ukrainian Group on Certification" was established in 2000 on the basis of framework developed by the World Council on Forestry Management. The area of

the certificated forests of this group accounted to 203 thousand hectares, and potential annual offer of certificated production of forestry - 360 thousand square meters. Forest certification in Zakarpatye Region is completed and certification in other Carpathian Region continues.

The policies, strategies and initiatives and their outcomes are described below:

In 1996-2005 State policy of Ukraine was aimed at the reaching of the following goals: development and support of domestic production; establishment of the competitive environment; ensuring of State food safety; trade development; rural development; civilian income support etc. It is necessary to note, that abovementioned years were years of agrarian reform and market economy formation during which significant challengers took place in industrial and social sphere, price and tax policy, mechanisms of financing and crediting as well as material maintenance in rural areas.

The important direction of State agricultural policy was reforming of privity and land ownership relations of property.

Providing of effective utilization of available production capabilities of the agro-industrial complex during transition to market economy, recession overcoming and stabilization of production, revival of economy are possible only under conditions of deep structural changes in agrarian economy on the basis of private ownership on property and land.

During the last 10 years the agricultural reform in Ukraine was implemented consistently enough. The following phasing of its implementation was planned:

- Land and privity reforming in agro-industrial complex;
- Establishment of new forms of collective agricultural enterprises on the basis of private ownership land and property with wide application of rent relations;

- Support of reformed and new farms and formation of market infrastructure in agriculture.

The aim of these large-scale activity was formation of effective agrarian sector of economy that should be based on profitable farms capable to compete with food producers of other countries.

In 1994-2002 the President of Ukraine signed a number of decrees on reforming of land and property relations, transfers of social sphere objects owned by collective agricultural enterprises to local government, protection of the rights of farmers and workers of social sphere of rural area, formation and functioning of the agrarian market etc. that were targeted at establishment of organizational base for implementation of laws of Ukraine and constitutional laws and civil liberties in rural area.

The main priorities of agrarian reform were aimed at formation of the real land and property owner, development of free enterprises in the real market environment, providing environment for profitable farming and increase of rural standards of living, ensuring the food safety and strengthening of Ukraine as agricultural State in the world food markets.

It is necessary to accent the following among the abovementioned decrees :

- The Decree of the President of Ukraine dated on December, 3, 1999 "On urgent measures on acceleration of reforming of agrarian sector of economy" promoting ownership reforming in agriculture by the way of collective agricultural enterprises reorganization on the basis of private management. The abovementioned decree started the appearance of real rural owner, interested in the results of his work;

- The Decree of the President of Ukraine dated on January, 29, 2001 № 62 "On measures on farm property right protection during reforming of agrarian sector of economy" that implemented the documentary ownership certification on property share and its disposability.

Since January, 1, 2002 the Land code of Ukraine which gave an opportunity to establish transparent system of registration and assessment as well as organize preconditions for land market implementation in Ukraine.

The Supreme Rada of Ukraine has imposed the moratorium on purchase and sale of agricultural land till 2007. Passing of the Law "On land market" will contribute to implementation of free land market relations and acceleration to the lifting of abovementioned moratorium.

Simultaneously with performance of land and property relation reforming gradual improvement of the agricultural producer access to credit resources took place.

Since 2000, the State budget of Ukraine have allocated the funds for the program of financial support of agricultural enterprises by the way of application of the mechanism of reduction in price of bank short-term credits and since 2004 for long-term credits as well.

Under this program agricultural enterprises receive compensation for short-term credits at the rate of 10 % annually in national currency and for long-term credits at the rate of 12-14 % annually at the expense of the State budget provided that royalty does not exceed 21 % annually.

It is also necessary to note that credit repayment by agricultural enterprises for five years amounted about 92 % at average. It means, that agricultural enterprises became full

partners of banks with which consider convenient to deal.

The law of Ukraine "On the State budget of Ukraine for 2006 "allocated the funds at the amount of 260 million grivnas on financial support of the agricultural enterprises by the way of application the mechanism of bank short and long-term credits.

Financial support of livestock and crop growing production was implemented in 2006 by the way granting of livestock production per unit and per hectare of sowing.

Among the activities targeted at the improvement of access of the enterprises of agro-industrial complex to financial resources, the special attention is paid to the attraction of foreign investments.

A number of legal acts were passed in 1996-2005 (the law of Ukraine "On foreign investment procedure", Custom, Economic and Civil Codes that established the basis of economical activity, custom policy and ensuring of contractual obligations performance. In the field of investment activity abovementioned acts are oriented at the ensuring of equal protection of the rights, interests and property of investment entities independently of patterns of ownership, as well as at the development of effective investment in national economy of Ukraine promotion of international cooperation and integration.

The structure and activity of the Advisory Council on Foreign Investments in Ukraine and the Commission of Experts of the Advisory Council were established by the Decree of the President of Ukraine dated on April, 11, 2005 № 625 "On additional measures on strengthening of the Advisory Council on Foreign Investments in Ukraine" .

Ukraine assumed during 2005 one-side actions for representatives of foreign business circles maximal liberalization of the procedure of crossing the frontier and staying in Ukraine for foreign citizens, as well as simplification of customs and boundary procedures performance.

Procedures of entrance into business and distribution of allowing documents were simplified. About 677 offices which provide registration of business entities applying the principle of "single window", and 490 offices providing distribution of allowing documents applying the integrated principle of organizational unity were established during the first half of 2005. By the end of 2005 "integrated offices" will be established in all regions and cities. Time for registration in corresponding bodies was reduced essentially for businessmen. Environment avoiding and preventing the abuse of single government employees was established.

As of September, 1, 2005 local government repealed and modified more than 2,5 thousand of regulatory acts and also about 200 regulatory acts of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine were repealed or modified. In accordance to the Decree of the President of Ukraine "On particular measures on ensuring of State regulatory policy implementation".

The Program On investment activity development for the period of 2002 - 2010 (the Decree of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated on December, 28, 2001 №1801) and the program "Investment image of Ukraine" (the Order of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated on August, 17, 2002 № 477-p) are extremely important for strengthening positive image of Ukraine and investment activity promotion.

About 41 billion grivnas of credit resources, almost 20 billion grivnas of which are on favorable terms were involved in agrarian sector of economy in 2000-2005. 7,4 billion

grivnas of credit resources were involved in agrarian sector of economy in 2005. 6,1 billion grivnas of credits were received on favorable terms, including 4,2 billion grivnas of short-term, and 1,9 billion grivnas of long-term credits. Agricultural enterprises received 10,4 billion grivnas of credit resources, including above 7,8 billion grivnas of preferential credits, among which 5,2 billion grivns of short-term credits (from them over 90 % of them are in national currency). Almost 2,6 billion grivnas of long-term credits were received (almost 90 % of them are in national currency).

As of January 1, 2006 1461,3 million USD of direct foreign investments (9,0 % of total amount of direct foreign investments involved in Ukrainian economy) were involved to agriculture of Ukraine since 1992 (data source: the State Committee of Statistics of Ukraine). 1169,3 million USD (7,2) of them were invested into 775 enterprises of food and processing industry and 292,0 million USD (1,8) - into 381 agricultural enterprises.

The results of implementation of the abovementioned reforms are as follows:

- 70,5 % agricultural lands (that is 29,5 million hectares) were transferred to the private property from national Land Fund which was in State ownership by the beginning of the reform;

- 6,9 million of farmers got the right on land share as the result of land sharing; 6,8 million (98 %) of farmers received certificates assuring this right;

- The owners of land shares are provided with State certificates on the land title right. 5,7 million State certificates or 83,5 % of total number of citizens received certificates in accordance with data as of January, 1, 2006;

- 16,1 thousand of agroformations of new type were established on the basis of 11,3 thousand of collective agricultural enterprises (CAE) during reforming. Among them there are 1,9 thousand farms (11,6 %), 3,6 thousand of private enterprises (22,6 %), 7,8 thousand of economic societies (48,7 %), 2,2 thousand of agricultural production cooperatives (13,8%), 0,1 thousand of serving cooperatives (0,1 %) and 0,4 thousand of other agroformations.

- 6,1 million of citizens received privity share, 5,8 million (94 %) of them received privity certificates.

- the total sum of the charged land rent amounted to 2,27 billion grivnas in 2005 according to the rent contracts .

- total sum of the charged property rent amounted to 74,1 million grivnas in 2005.

One of the main current tasks of Ukraine is the further development of market oriented agriculture, establishment and functioning of marketing system together with implementation the measures on formation of market infrastructure of production, processing and distribution of production, expansion of domestic and search of perspective foreign markets.

Agricultural serving cooperatives possesses special place in the marketing circuit of production movement from producer to consumer. They defend the interests of its members - agricultural commodity producers - involving them to trade, give an opportunity to impact the prices, and also provide an entry to the wholesale markets. Work on expansion of network of such entities continues. It is targeted at the improvement of commodity fill-

ing of agricultural commodity market with agricultural products and granting services to agricultural producers. Over thousand of such entities were established as of November, 1, 2005.

Regional and local agro-trade houses undertake further functions on formation of wholesale sets of agricultural production for selling in the markets. There are about 390 of such entities working at regional level. Nevertheless the majority of them works as commercial entities and only 103 - as cooperative.

Formation of formal wholesale and small wholesale markets of agricultural commodity, as one of the elements of agricultural commodity market infrastructure is still one of the most urgent issues in Ukraine. Spontaneous market relations are not self-sufficient and demand organizational intervention both of producers, consumers of agricultural commodity production and of the State.

Development of the domestic agricultural commodity market and international agricultural commodity commerce is the important direction of the State policy.

Policy targeted at the ensuring of State food safety is of special importance with respect to implementation of the decision of the World Food Summit on reduction of number of starving people in 2 times till 2015. Thereupon a special attention is given to the policy targeted at encouraging of the abovementioned food and agricultural production and to the ensuring of the appropriate level of agro-industrial complex product safety and quality as well as introduction of the world production standards.

As it was mentioned above in section 1 of the abovementioned Report, food-processing industry of Ukraine is capable to file the home market of Ukraine with food stuffs, as well as to export abovementioned production.

Last years the President of Ukraine, the Supreme Rada of Ukraine and the Government of Ukraine passed a number of legal acts targeted at the increasing of the domestic production competitiveness. Concept of the State policy in the field of food quality management was developed that gave a new push for implementation of concrete measures in industry.

The Ministry of Agricultural Policy of Ukraine work on establishment of the national normative documentation in the field of food industry, harmonized with international and European standards.

142 normative documents met the world requirements in 2002-2004. In 2005 142 standards and 12 technical rules were developed. More than 100 normative documents require development and harmonization.

For ensuring of inter-integration with the world community, where modern methods of quality and environment management are used on the basis of the requirements ISO 9000 and 14000 and for food safety - on the basis of principles of system HACCP, at 44 food enterprises food quality control systems are developed, implemented and certified in line with requirements of standards ISO 9000; at 4 enterprises - control systems of an environment meeting the requirements of standards ISO 14000; at 6 enterprises - food safety control systems of on the basis of HACCP principles are developed, implemented and certified and at 32 food enterprises this work continues.

Sustainable development of agriculture closely connected with rural development.

The State support of rural social sphere is regulated by the Law of Ukraine "On priority of agriculture and rural social development in national economy" and a number of other laws.

The rural Ukraine today consists of 28 585 rural settlements in which 15 271 thousand people live, that is 32% of the total population of Ukraine. Share of retired population is 39%. The amount of rural settlements decreased on 12 units, and agricultural population on 204 thousands persons as of January, 1, 2004.

The primary goals of rural social sphere development are the following:

- Establishment of enabling environment for effective rural employment on the basis of effective use of rural natural potential, promotion entrepreneurship development providing formation of new workplaces and considerable increase in incomes;
- Encouragement of youth to work and live in the rural area;
- Formation of social infrastructure, capable to satisfy different needs of rural population;
- Prevention of decline of rural settlements, expansion of possibilities of rural communities in solving of vital activity issues.

All abovementioned tasks are priorities of the State policy of rural development both at the nearest and average prospect.

Strategy of poverty overcoming is implemented since 2001, Integrated program of ensuring implementation of this Strategy is developed, the plan of the concrete targeted at poverty overcoming is ratified annually regular monitoring of poverty parameters is provided. Regional programs of poverty overcoming are developed and being implementing.

The main efforts concentrate on the following basic directions: employment policy acceleration; ensuring of monetary incomes growth of the population and reduction of their differentiation on the basis of salary and pension increasing; strengthening of the population address support.

The measures authorized by the Orders of Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated on 23.12.2004 № 957-p were implemented during 2005.

Due to the result of implementation of employment support measures the constant tendency to the improvement of situation in the employment market was maintained. For this purpose the legal base is regularly improved, work on improvement of quality and efficiency of labour management is taken and also such measures are implemented as activity on preservation and establishment of workplaces, population employment promotion and prevention of mass unemployment, ensuring of social security of registered unemployed etc.

Increase of incomes of citizens is provided, particularly, by the way of implementation of the systems of State social standards, reaching the living wage by the sizes of the State social guarantees and approximation of their sizes to European standards.

Since 2005 the minimal pensions equal to living minimum are granted to persons who lost ability to work, the differentiation of pensions is restored with respect to the experience of work, the size of the minimal salary is increased, payments to invalids were increased greatly depending on the group of physical inability, payments to low-income persons were increased. Disposable payment at a birth of the child increased essentially and established at a rate of 8500 grivnas.

Nominal incomes of the population have increased by 38,4 % in 2005 comparing with the previous year. Available incomes which can be used by the population for purchase of goods and services, have increased by 36,4 %, and real incomes– by 20,1 %.

- Average salary per month increased by 36,7 % in 2005 comparing with 2004 and was 806,18 grivnas. Real salary thus increased by 20,3 %.

Monitoring of assessment the situation with poverty during implementation of Strategy of poverty overcoming since 2001 shows stable tendencies of indexes. At twice increase the poverty line from 170 grivnas in 2001 to 270 grivnas, calculated on the basis of relative criterion, the level of poverty for this time has remained equal to 27 %.

It is possible to make also a conclusion concerning positive changes performing integrated assessment of changes of poverty overcoming which consists of poverty evaluation applying different criteria, .

The analysis of poverty on the basis of absolute criterion that includes daily consumption cost index equal to 4,3 USD (based on the parity of purchasing capacity), chosen as a target reference point in UN Millennium Development Goals shows significant reduction of poverty level in Ukraine from 11% in 2001 to 3,2% in 2004.
